A literature review is an important part of any research paper. It helps your audience understand the territory you're covering by identifying what work has been done on your subject. It also connects you to a continuous scholarly discussion that crosses countless disciplines, decades and subject areas. In addition, it can help you identify gaps in existing research that you can fill with your own study.

For this assignment, you will read and summarize books, articles, websites, and other sources related to your research topic. You will then analyze and critique these sources. This type of assignment is commonly required in college courses, and it will help you develop your skills as a researcher.

<u>Presentation</u> of family health nursing and explores psycho-socio-cultural, economic, spiritual, community, and educational paradigms to promote a healthy family system. The student will complete a project, evaluate the outcomes, propose a plan to disseminate the results and make a formal scholarly presentation to faculty and peers at the end of the semester.

## **NR 623 Final Project**

Students complete a master's level scholarly project during this semester-long seminar. The project must focus on promoting health, preventing illness and disability, or alleviating health disparities in practice or educational settings. Students meet weekly to discuss the final project, participate in peer-review activities, and make a formal scholarly presentation at the end of the <a href="nurs fpx 6021">nurs fpx 6021</a> assessment 2 change strategy and implementation. This is the required capstone course for the Master's Degree Track.

## **NR 624 Reflective Essay**

Reflective essays are personal essays that examine a topic through the lens of the writer's unique perspective. They are more subjective about their subjects than an academic essay, use figurative language, and don't require academic sources. These essays can be written for many purposes, including college applications and job applications. They can also be used as a means of self-discovery and <a href="POLI 330N Week 7">POLI 330N Week 7</a> Assignment Final Project Policy Issue.

While reflective essays are not required to follow a traditional structure, it is generally good practice to include an introduction, body paragraphs, and a conclusion. It is also important to avoid slang and familiar language in these types of essays. Additionally, a final reading of the essay should be conducted for spelling and grammatical errors.

The reflective essay is an opportunity for the student to articulate their growth as information professionals and develop a professional information philosophy. The essay will be written using the APA writing style and should be between 1300-1500 words, with suitable and NR 504 Week 3 Reflective Essay citation practices followed (final word count excludes Works Cited). In the essay the student will demonstrate their competency in two learning outcomes and use two course artifacts to support their proficiency in these outcomes.
